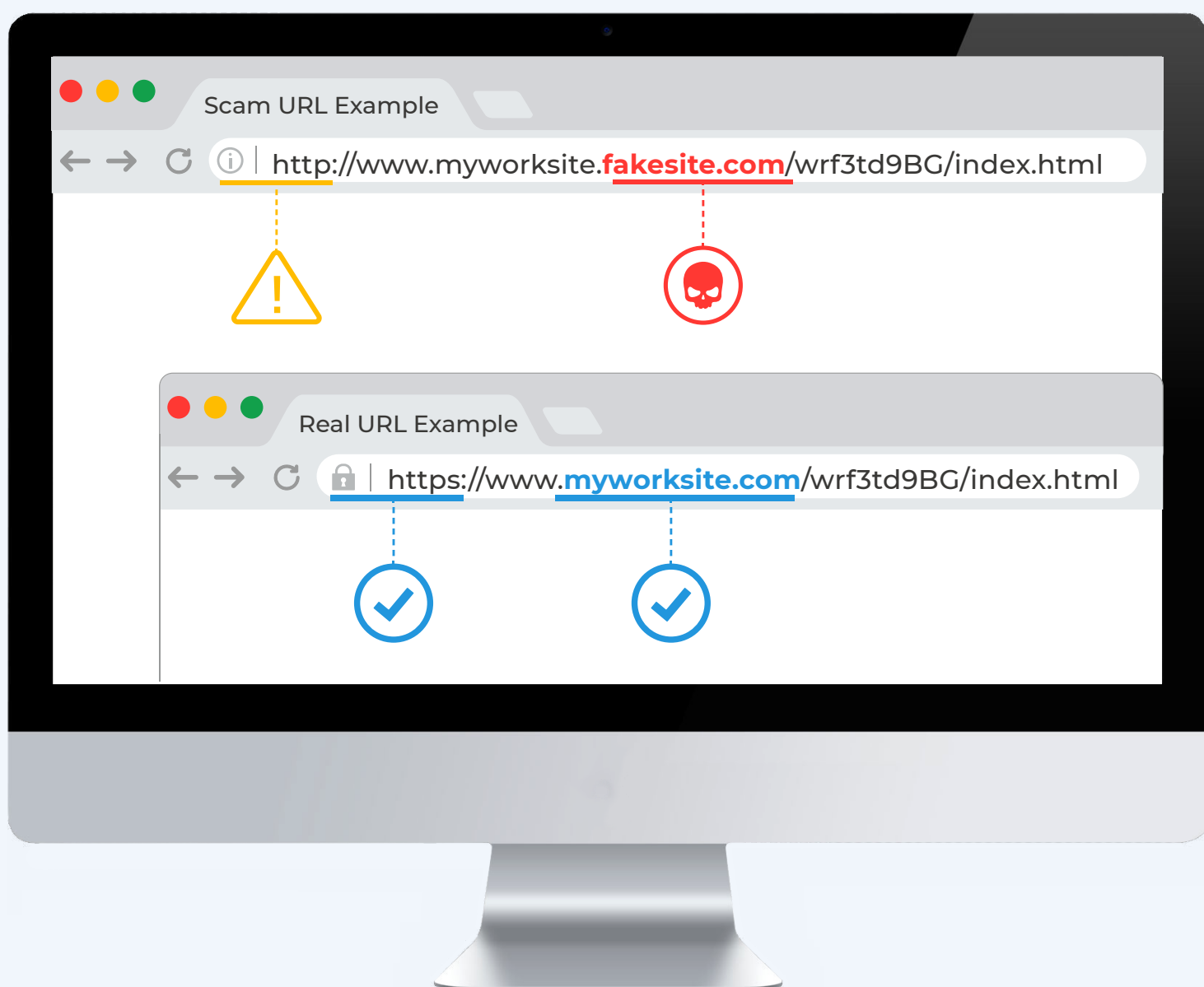

Spot Bad URLs:

- 1 The end of a URL before the first single forward slash ("/") is what matters. Ignore the subdomain, folder, and page name.
- 2 Use sites that are security enabled with HTTPS. Data can be intercepted by third parties with HTTP.
